VINYL AFTER CARE

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INITIAL AFTERCARE

Please do not wash or expose to rain for the first 48hrs. The film is still curing during this time, moisture will affect the way the edges and adhesive set.

MAINTENANCE

Our vinyl wraps are installed by professionals with high attention to detail. Vinyl however is not a permanent finish, vinyl peeling/popping on edges or tight corners is completely normal. If there is any visible edges lifting, no need to stress! Majority of the time this is an easy fix. We check in with our customers 6-12 weeks after install, and offer all our customers a check up free of charge to ensure your wrap has the longest lifespan.

WHAT SOAP SHOULD I USE?

It is recommended to use a pH neutral car shampoo.



HOW OFTEN SHOULD I WASH MY CAR?

We recommend washing your vehicle atleast once a week.

HOW DO I WASH MY VEHICLE?

Handwash is the preferred method of washing, if you wish to use a 'drive-thru' wash ensure it's brushless. Always use a clean sponge or soft cloth with pH neutral shampoo to wash your wrap. Rinse vehicle with clear water after washing. Always dry wrap with chamois/automotive blow dryer to avoid water spotting.



HOW LONG DOES WRAP LAST?

A well maintained wrap has a life-span of upto 7 years. Assuming you take good care of the wrap & vehicle is garaged overnight.

CAN I USE A PRESSURE WASHER?

When using a pressure washer take extra precaution, keep spray nozzle atleast 1 metre away at all times. This prevents edges lifting and ripping.

IS CERAMIC COATING SAFE FOR MY WRAP?

Ceramic coating on vinyl wrap is safe. Ensure the coating is installed by a professional and is the correct coating for vinyl. Incorrect types of ceramic coat can ruin the adhesive and finish.

CAN I BUFF / POLISH MY WRAP?

No. Polish and cutting compounds will damage the top coat on the vinyl. A buffer can lift or tear the vinyl.
